## Course Summary

### THE SUBJECT

The Welsh course is broad and varied. Students are given the opportunity to explore the wealth of the Welsh literary tradition from the 6th century to the present day. By discussing and analysing contemporary literature and film, oral skills are developed. Students will also be able to develop their writing skills through creative, factual and analytical writing. They will be expected to read widely.

### SUBJECT SKILLS

- To communicate fluently and with confidence in oral and written work, and in a wide range of forms, situations and contexts.
- To show an appreciation of the content, form, style and language of literary material from the 6th century to the present day, and including the modern multi-media culture.
- To express an independent opinion, and to consider and react to different viewpoints and opinions.
- To show an understanding of literary contexts spanning a range of forms and periods, and to explore the relationship between texts.
